A key aim of our education support is to equip school professionals with the confidence, skills and understanding they need to respond to the death of a student effectively. We work alongside schools to ensure staff feel supported, prepared and able to care for their community.

Compassionate support when a child dies

The death of a pupil has a profound impact on the whole school community.

Our service offers dedicated, sensitive support to help schools navigate the impact of the bereavement.

We provide compassionate bereavement advice and guidance for:

- Teaching and support staff
- Pupils and Peer groups
- Parents

Grief is a lifelong journey and children benefit enormously from consistent, informed support throughout their education.



Support available to schools

Staff consultation meetings - tailored advice and guidance for the school following the death of a pupil.





Staff support sessions - a reflective space for colleagues to debrief, explore the emotional impact and consider the needs of the wider school community.

Peer group bereavement support - sessions led by a trained bereavement counsellor to support pupils directly affected by the loss.

Parent grief support and education - helping parents understand and respond to their children's needs following the death of a peer.
